



The Hub City Soccer concession stands at the Moccasin Creek Soccer Complex are used by almost everybody in the club, and are a very important resource for the club. At times, it can be difficult to staff the concession stands to provide concession services during our various Spring/Summer/Fall leagues. Normally, concession stand volunteers are Spring/Fall Youth League parents, but we have found that sometimes we are still short of help. To try to help fill these openings in our concession stand schedule, HCSC is offering an opportunity for competitive soccer parents to earn credit towards the next competitive season player fees by working in the concession stand when the need arises.

How does this work?

If you are interested in this, simply e-mail the Hub City Soccer office at [aberdeensoccer@nvc.net](mailto:aberdeensoccer@nvc.net), give us your name and contact information (preferably an e-mail or phone number we can text to), and let us know that you are interested. Your name will then go on a list, and when the concession stand has time slots available they cannot fill, you will be contacted, and asked to fill in as needed. We will work down the list of people so that everyone has a chance to participate as the opportunities come up. Each time slot is roughly 1 ½-2 hours (some are just an hour) and would generally be for Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays or Saturdays. For each time slot that you would fill in, we will provide you with a \$10.00 credit off the next competitive season fees.

If you are a parent that has children in both the spring/fall youth league programs and the competitive program and did not pay the optional opt out fee, or provide coaching in the spring or fall leagues, this credit opportunity applies to the second time that you sign up to volunteer as the Spring/Fall youth league parents are asked to volunteer at least one time-slot as a Spring/Fall youth league parent.

**Please know you are absolutely not required to participate in this program**, and that this is simply an opportunity for those who are looking for ways to reduce the cost of playing competitive soccer.

The Spring League Season has a tentative start date of April 14<sup>th</sup>, so if this is something of interest to you, please let us know as soon as you can, and we will get you on the list to contact about openings. Thank you.
